Restricted Instruction Permit (RIP) Not Issued by DMV

From: Driver Education Program Specialist, NC DMV School Bus & Traffic Safety (SBTS) Office

A representative of the NCDMV recently made a visit to your child's Driver Education class for the purpose of issuing the Restricted Instruction Permit (used for Behind-the-Wheel instruction), which included a vision and medical screening. If you are receiving this notice, the DMV was unable to issue the R.I.P. at the time of the visit. **Note:** A representative from the NCDMV **does not** come to give these screenings to the Saturday Driver Education classes. All students needing to be screened by one of our representatives must come to a DMV office to have this check completed, as well as to have their Restricted Permit paperwork signed by a DMV official. Please follow the directions below:

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ISSUANCE OF RESTRICTED INSTRUCTION PERMIT:

1 – You must have: The Restricted Instruction Permit (R.I.P.) paperwork from Jordan Driving School. It must be completely filled out and signed (black or blue ink only)

2 – You must have: Acceptable forms of ID (certified birth certificate AND original SS card (NO PHOTOCOPIES))

3 – Parent or legal guardian must accompany the student to any NC DMV Driver License office for testing

4 – Corrective lenses, if required

You may visit any NC DMV Driver License Office in the State of NC.
